Georgia EPD requires that the following notice be posted. Please note that the City of Bowdon has substantial water resources. The following notice is a precautionary measure implemented by the State of Georgia:

Drought Public Information Campaign

As of September 9, 2016, the State of Georgia has implemented a Level 1 Drought for 53 counties in Georgia including Carroll County. This condition is due to the lack of rainfall in recent months. The City of Bowdon has stable water resources and is managing these resources in order to ensure that Bowdon is able to meet the needs of you, our customers.

We all need to practice “Due Diligence” to ensure that the City of Bowdon continues to maintain adequate water supply.

- Customers should do the following:
 - Regularly check for and repair, leaks inside and outside their home
 - Adjust sprinklers so only your lawn is watered and not the house, sidewalk or street
- Under Drought Response Level 1: activities that may be done any time of the day:
 - Irrigation of personal food gardens may be done at any time of the day;
 - Irrigation of new and replanted plant, seed, or turf may be done at any time of day for 30 days after installation;
 - Drip irrigation or irrigation using soaker hoses may be done at any time of day; and
 - Hand watering with a hose with automatic cutoff or handheld container may be done at any time of day.
- General landscape watering may be done between 4 pm and 10 am each day.
